How about a Game of Baseball Thoughts



We are well over half-way through this baseball season, and it has been a season of rule changes, improved hitting, improved defense, and surprise teams. One of those surprise teams has been the Arizona Diamondbacks. Whatever they do this season they have done way beyond what many thought they might do. They actually led the Western Division of the National League more than any other team up until the All-Star Break. I thought of some of the unusual things that have occurred in my lifetime during the baseball season and realize that fame and lasting glory are more often carried on in 'verbal legends than in always checking the facts.'

Sharon and I went to see the movie, "It Ain't Over", the docudrama about the life of Yogi Berra, who played for the New York Yankees and coached the New York Mets and the New York Yankees. Yogi played in more World Series Championships teams than any other player in baseball—10 and was one of 7 players to win the Most Valuable Player of their league 3 times. The all-time leader in winning the Most Valuable Player award was Barry Bonds—7 times, but his possible involvement with performance enhancing drugs keeps him off the list of many baseball experts. I thought you might enjoy knowing the other six three-time champions for their league: American League; Jimmie Foxx, Alex Rodriguez, and Mike Trout; National League; Stan Musial, Roy Campanella, and Albert Pujols. I would be surprised if all 7 of these players were listed on anyone's choice of the 10 greatest players in modern era baseball, since 1931. It is interesting that the stats and awards may say one thing, but often the player's personality and reputation carries the day. Baseball is a lot like life.

My encouragement to you is to follow the advice of Paul, "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth." II Timothy 2:15 He is truly the one who calls everyone safe or out!!
